Following receipt of your complaint, the Office of the Environment Officer conducted a site visit and engaged the Headteacher of the institution. The school administration was formally instructed to block the existing discharge point and redirect the storm water into an appropriate drainage channel to prevent further encroachment into your property.

A follow-up inspection has confirmed that the required corrective measures have been undertaken. The storm water has been properly redirected, and the matter is considered resolved.



**RE: RESPONSE TO COMPLAINT ON DISCHARGE OF DIRTY WATER FROM BUTCHERIES**


Reference is made to your complaint dated 07/08/2024 regarding certain butcheries discharging dirty water onto public walkways within Oyugis town

Following your report, the Office of the Environment Officer conducted a site inspection and confirmed that some operators were improperly disposing of waste water onto pedestrian pathways, thereby creating a public health risk and environmental nuisance.

Consequently, formal warning notices have been issued to the concerned butcheries in accordance with the Public Health Act and the Environmental Management and Coordination Act. They have been directed to immediately cease the practice and to ensure proper waste water management through approved drainage systems. Failure to comply will attract enforcement measures as provided under the law.

The Municipality appreciates your vigilance and commitment to maintaining environmental sanitation standards in Oyugis. Kindly continue to report any further non-compliance for prompt action.



**RE: RESPONSE TO COMPLAINT DATED 23/12/2024 – ILLEGAL WASTE DISPOSAL**


Reference is made to your complaint dated 23/12/2024 regarding illegal waste disposal on your land adjacent to Nyadendi Hotel.



**RE: RESPONSE TO COMPLAINT DATED 06/11/2024 – DISCHARGE OF WASTE  
WATER ALONG R1-001 ROAD**

Reference is made to your complaint dated 06/11/2024 concerning residents along R1-001 Road, currently under construction by your company, who were discharging waste water onto the road surface and thereby hindering construction activities.

Upon receipt of the complaint, the Office of the Environment Officer conducted a site inspection and confirmed the reported non-compliance. Formal warning and remediation notices were subsequently issued to the affected residents, directing them to immediately cease the discharge of waste water onto the road and to implement appropriate disposal measures.

A follow-up inspection has established that the residents have complied with the directives issued, and the obstruction to the ongoing road works has been addressed. The matter is therefore considered resolved and the case closed.
