This amount includes **Kshs. 25,595,629.65** realized from Sub-Counties, **Kshs. 2,751,230.00** from Trade department deposited direct into CRF account as liquor licensing and **Kshs. 199,518,297.00** generated by health facilities as Appropriation-In-Aid.

During the said period HOMA WASCO reported to have collected **Kshs. 15,681,786.50** as revenue for the month.

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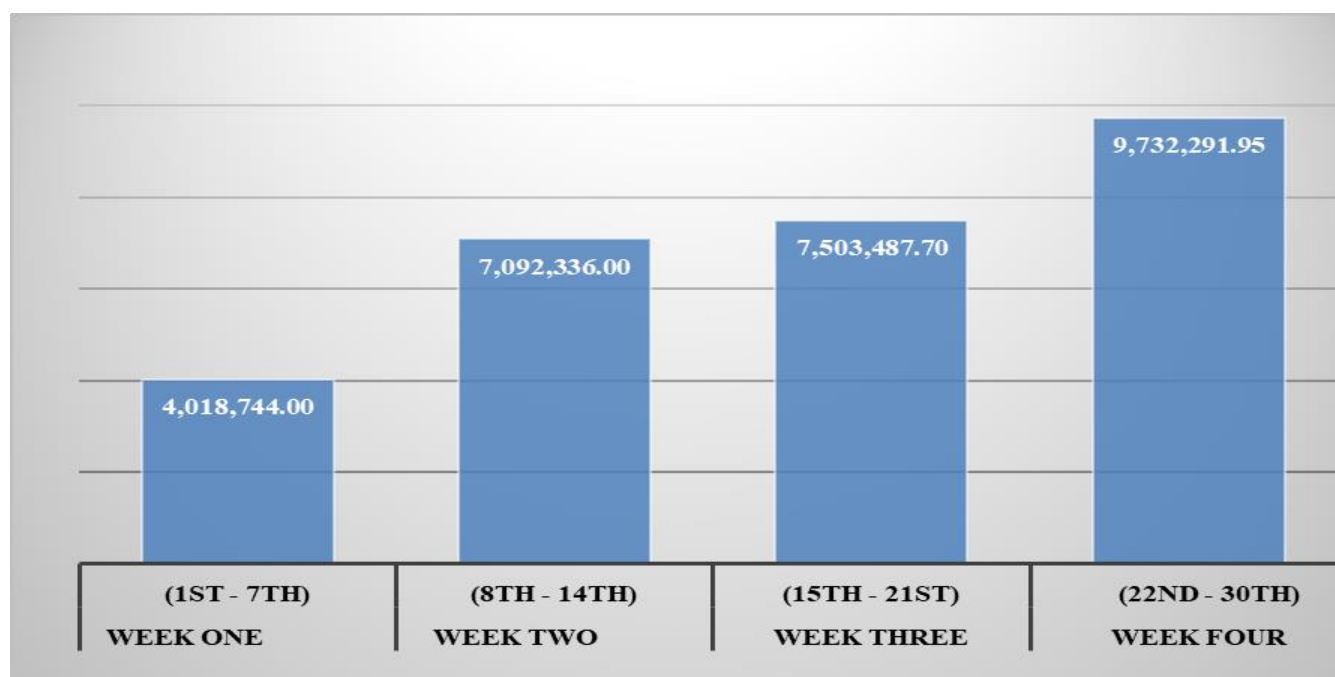
1.0: REVENUE PERFORMANCE REPORT

The total Own Source Revenue realized in the month of June 2025 amounts to **Kshs. 227,865,156.65** which includes **Kshs. 199,518,297.00** from Health department, **Kshs. 25,595,629.65** from Sub-Counties and **Kshs. 2,751,230.00** from Trade department swiped direct into CRF account as Liquor Licensing. Chart 1.2: Performance of Sub Counties Revenue Collections – June 2025

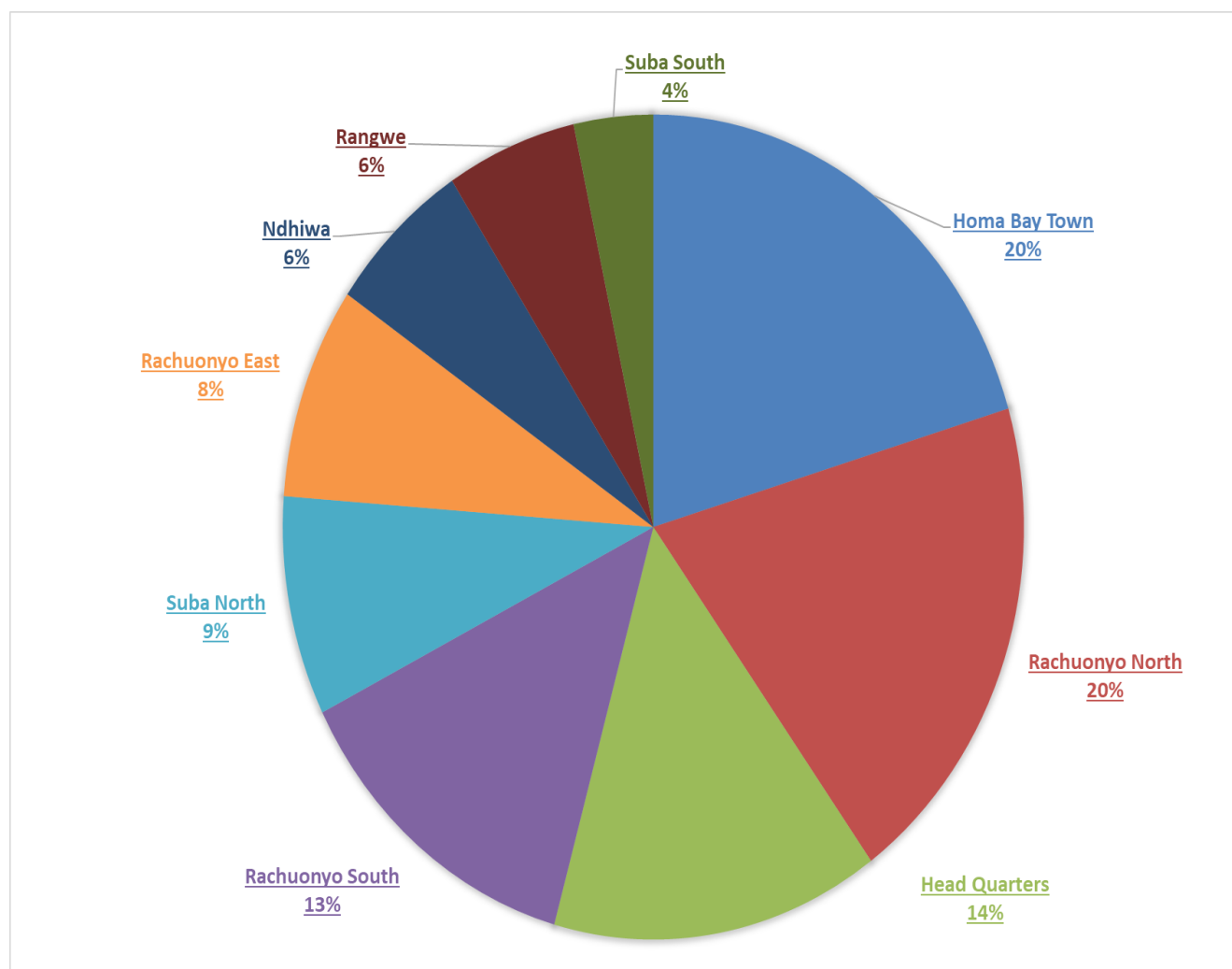

Chart 1.3: Total Revenue Collections Performance by Sub-Counties

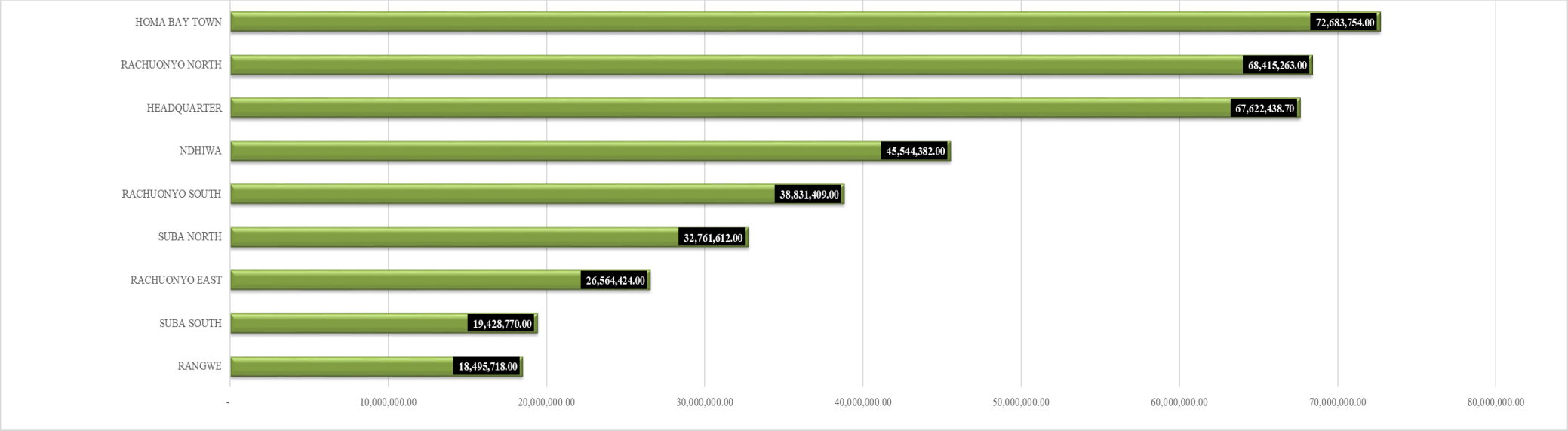

Chart 1.4: Total Monthly Revenue Collections Trend Report

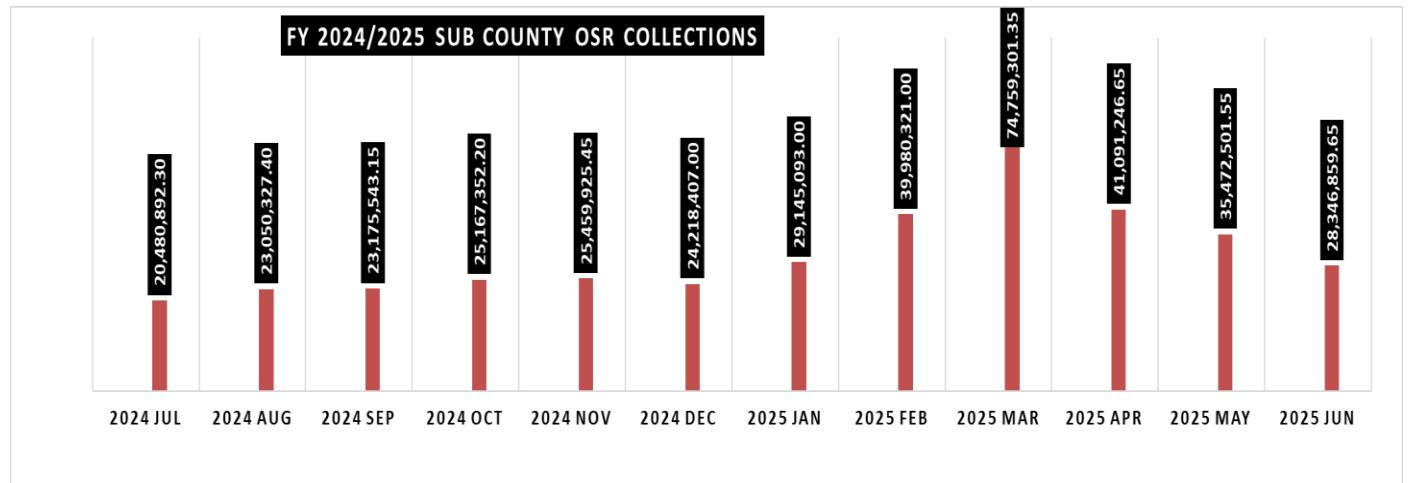
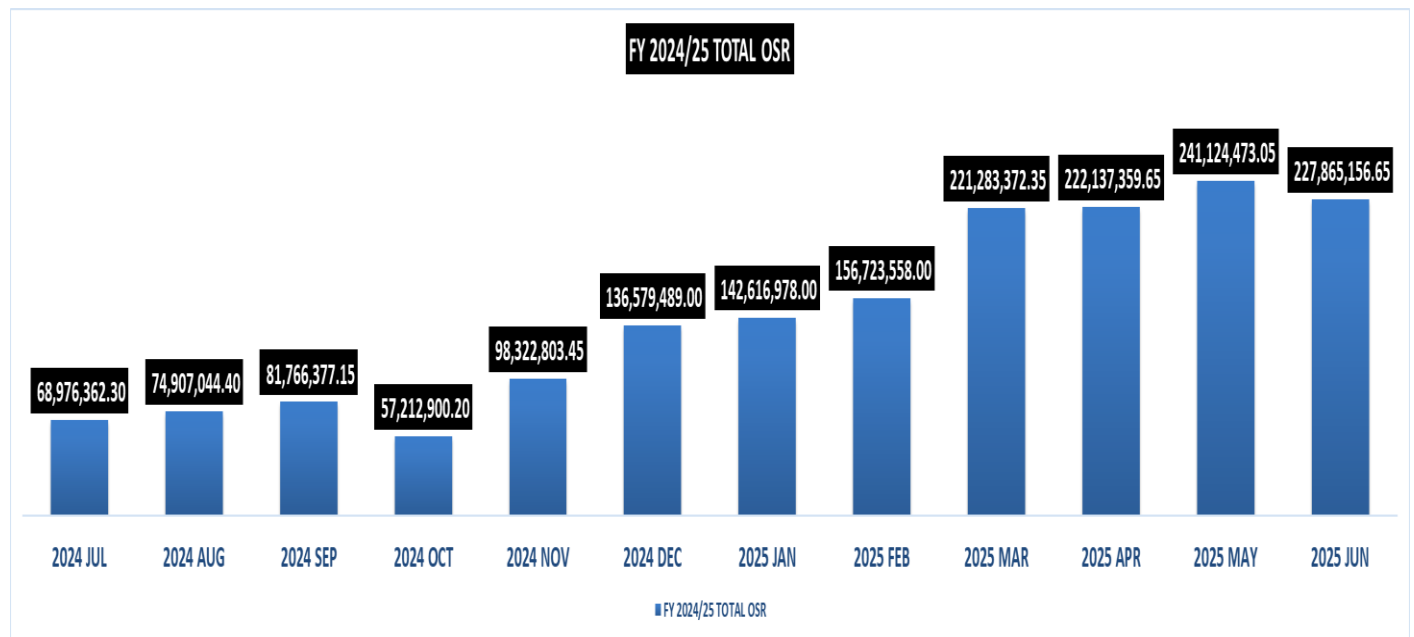


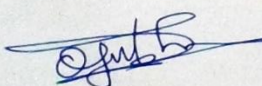
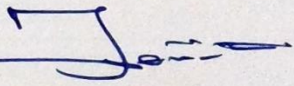
Chart 1.5: Total OSR FY 2024/25

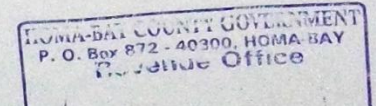

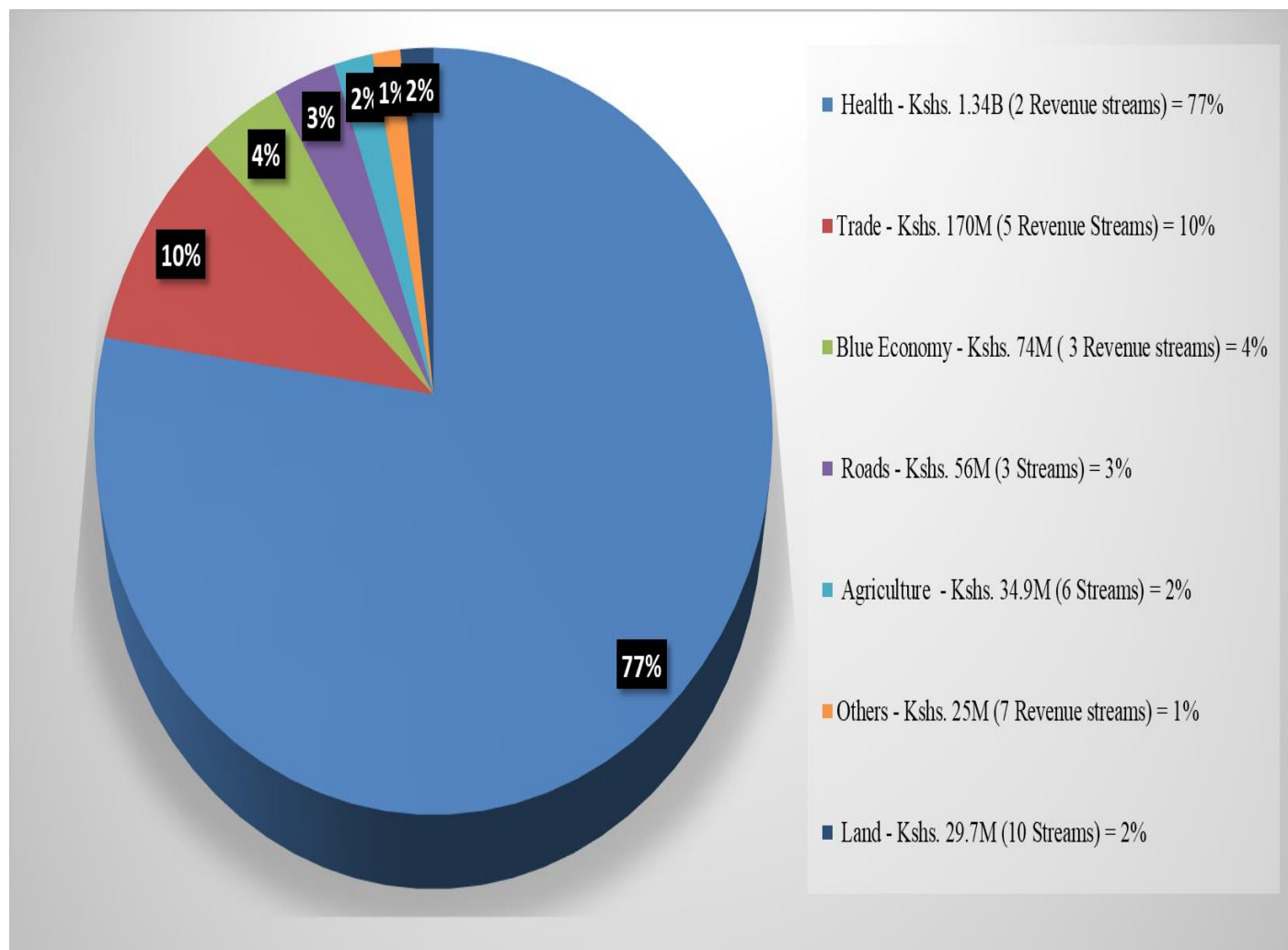

Graph 5.1: Municipalities Revenue Collections Performance – June 2025

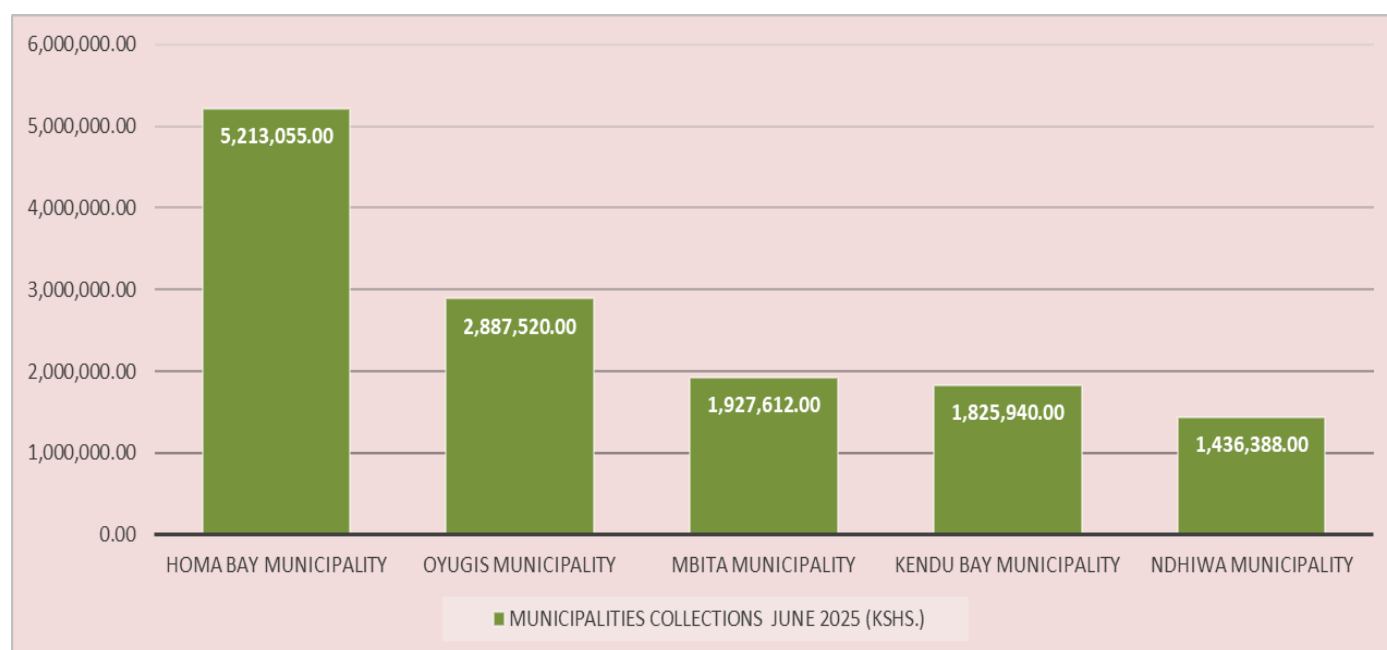

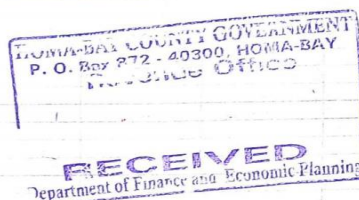
